# HOW DOES TUCKSHOP WORK?

## WHAT IS TUCKSHOP?

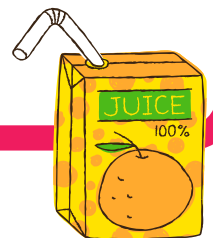
Tuckshop is a welcome service for parents that provides a range of meal options from snacks and sandwiches through to hot home made meals. It is run by the School P&C and proceeds are used to pay some staff and maintain the tuckshop equipment. Any profits are invested back in the school for P&C initiatives.

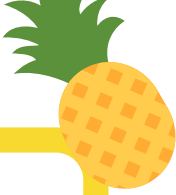
## HOW DOES IT WORK?

You can place your child's order online through Flexischools. This can be done a few days in advance OR before 8:15am on the day. The Tuckshop team will prepare the items for that day. Your child's order will be placed in a labelled bag into their classroom tuckshop box. Each class is assigned a pair of tuckshop monitors for the day who will come to the tuckshop and collect their rooms box at the appropriate time. The monitors then take the box of orders back to their respective eating area. For Grades Prep and One, the box is handed to the teacher on duty who assists in handing the orders out to the correct child.

## WHAT IF MY CHILD IS SICK THAT DAY?

Orders for tuckshop can be placed in advance. If your child is away from school on a day that you had placed a tuckshop order, call the tuckshop in the morning (preferably by 9am) so that the order can be held off to another day of your choosing.





## WHAT HAPPENS WITH FROZEN ITEMS

All frozen items are listed on your child's label. For Grades 1 through 6, all frozen items ordered are held in the tuckshop until your child is ready to eat them. When ready, your child will bring their label to the tuckshop to redeem their frozen item. For children in Prep, frozen items are included in their tuckshop box.

## OVER THE COUNTER SALES

At the second break, children can come to the tuckshop and purchase a selection of items with cash. This is a great opportunity for children to experience handling cash and making independent decisions.

## LEADERSHIP STUDENTS

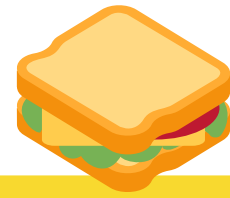
Students in grade 5 who wish to participate in the leadership development program have the opportunity to assist in tuckshop.

They are rostered onto 15 minute shifts, where they assist in duties such as labelling the lunch bags and drinks for the day, and restocking items.

## DIETARY NEEDS

The Tuckshop tries to provide a selection of items that caters to most dietary needs. Please be aware that although the tuckshop will have items that do not contain gluten, the kitchen itself is not a gluten free environment.





## **FORGOTTEN LUNCH**

From time to time, students may forget to bring their packed lunch from home, or they may drop their lunch at school and it is not edible. On these occasions the school office will try to contact a parent. Tuckshop can assist with preparing food for the day and an IOU will be issued.

## **VOLUNTEERING IN TUCKSHOP**

Volunteers in tuckshop are vital in ensuring this service is available and the menu is affordable. No experience is needed. The tasks are easy and manageable. Generally, shifts are divided into either a morning service (9am - 11:30am) or the lunch service (12:00pm - 2:00pm). All parents are welcomed to be a part of the team. It is a great way to meet other parents and children are always so excited seeing their parents during the day at school. The roster is very flexible catering for those who wish to volunteer on a regular basis through to those who can only spare a couple of hours a term. We'd love to have you join our friendly team.
